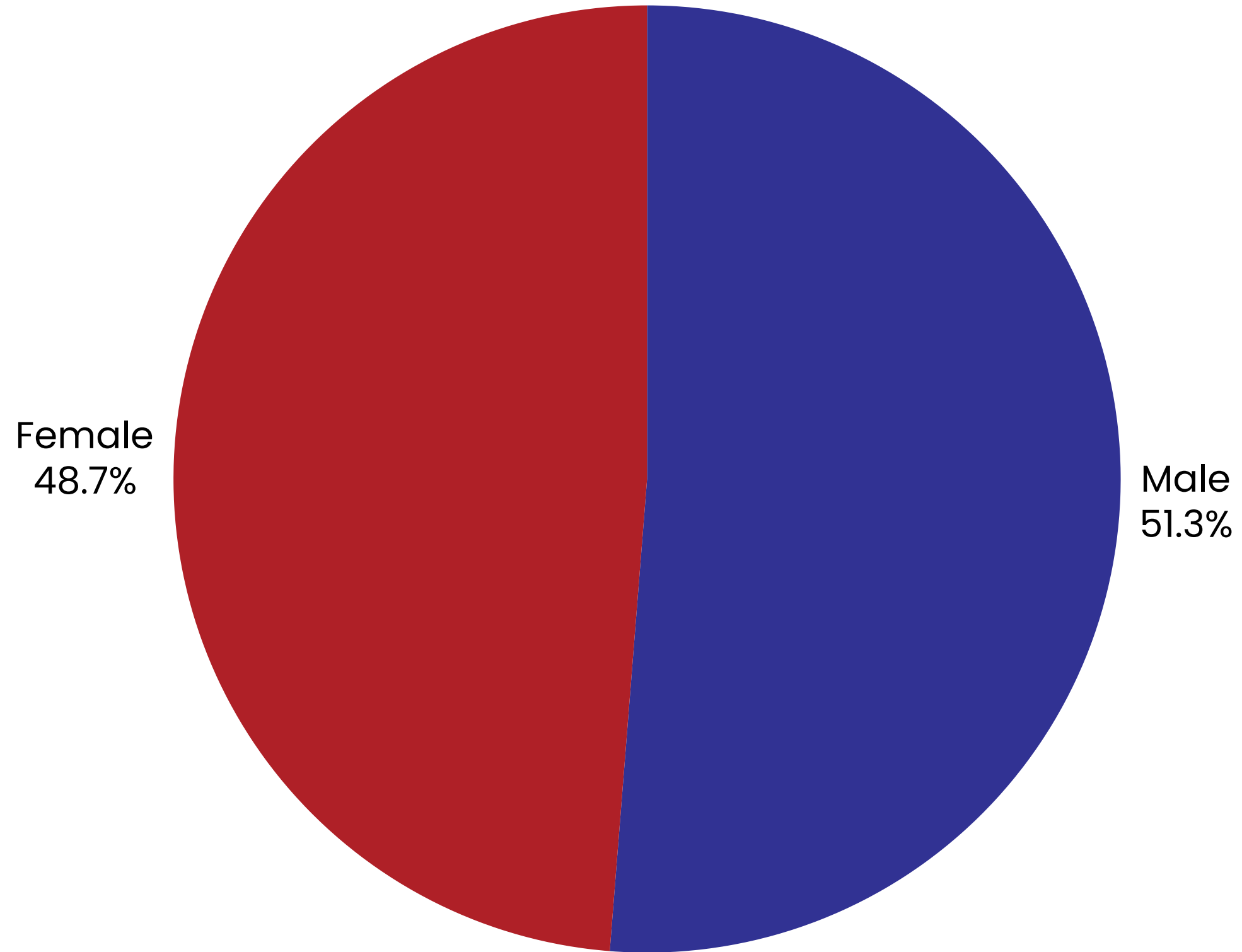

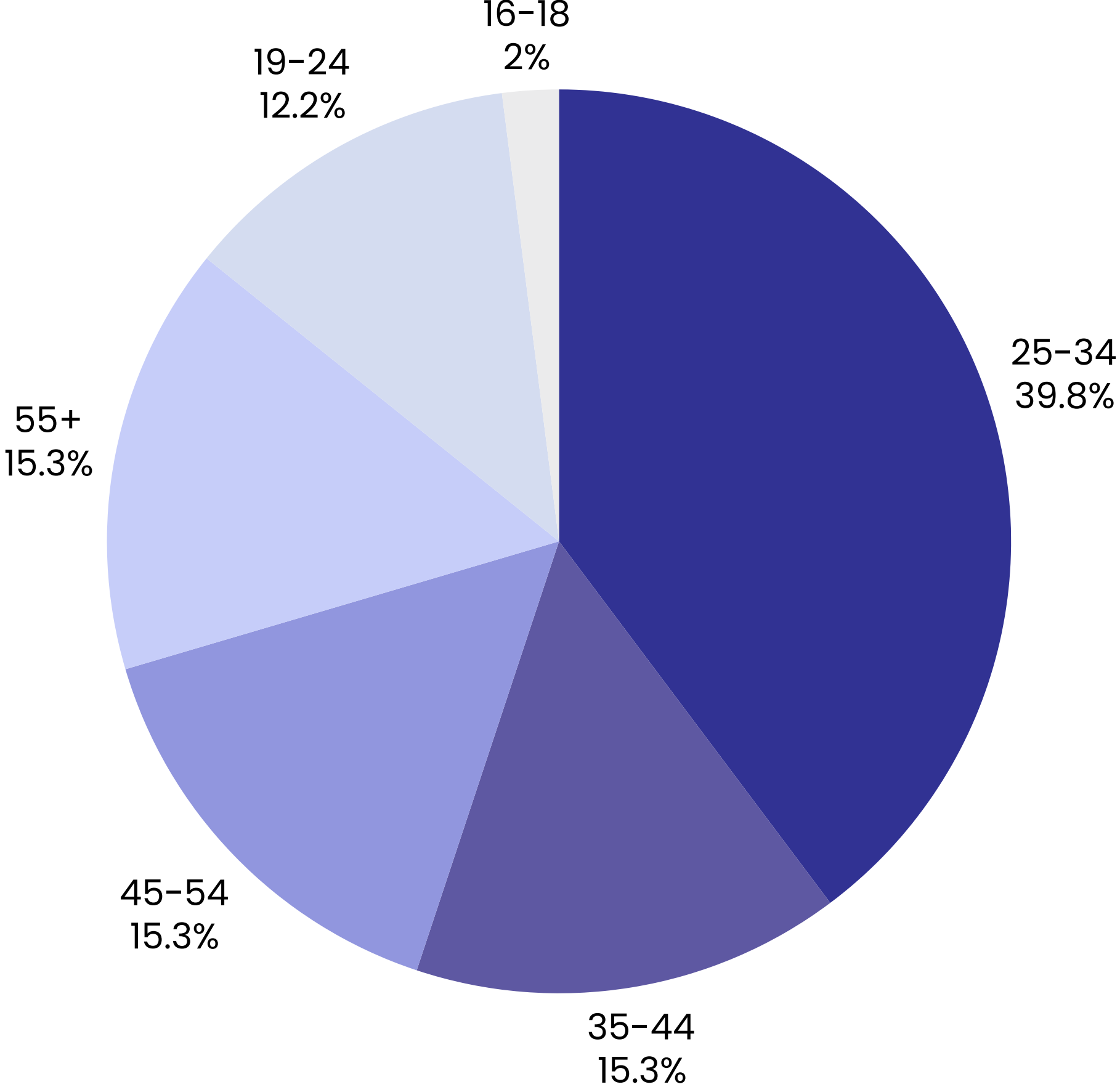

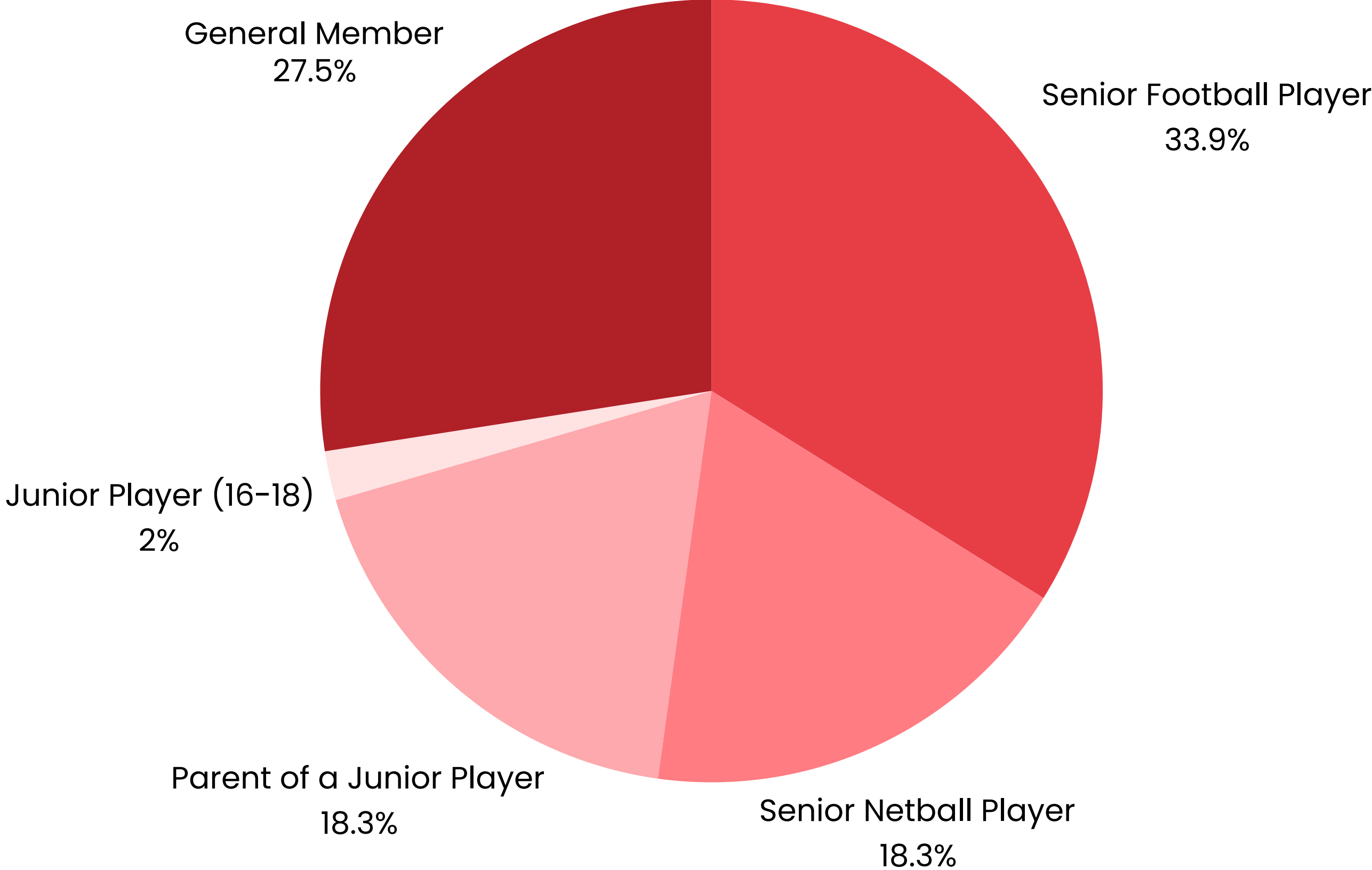
What is your gender?



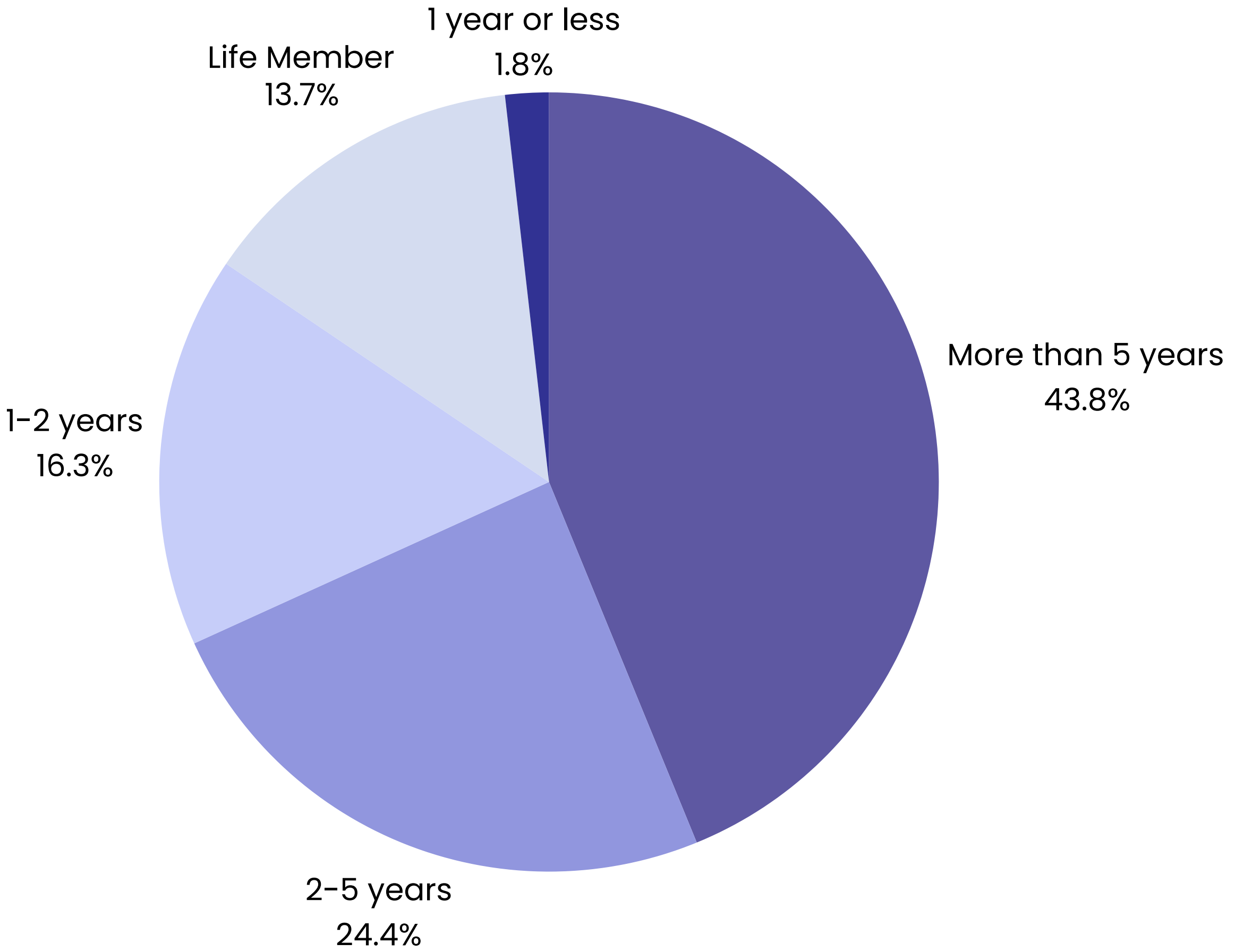

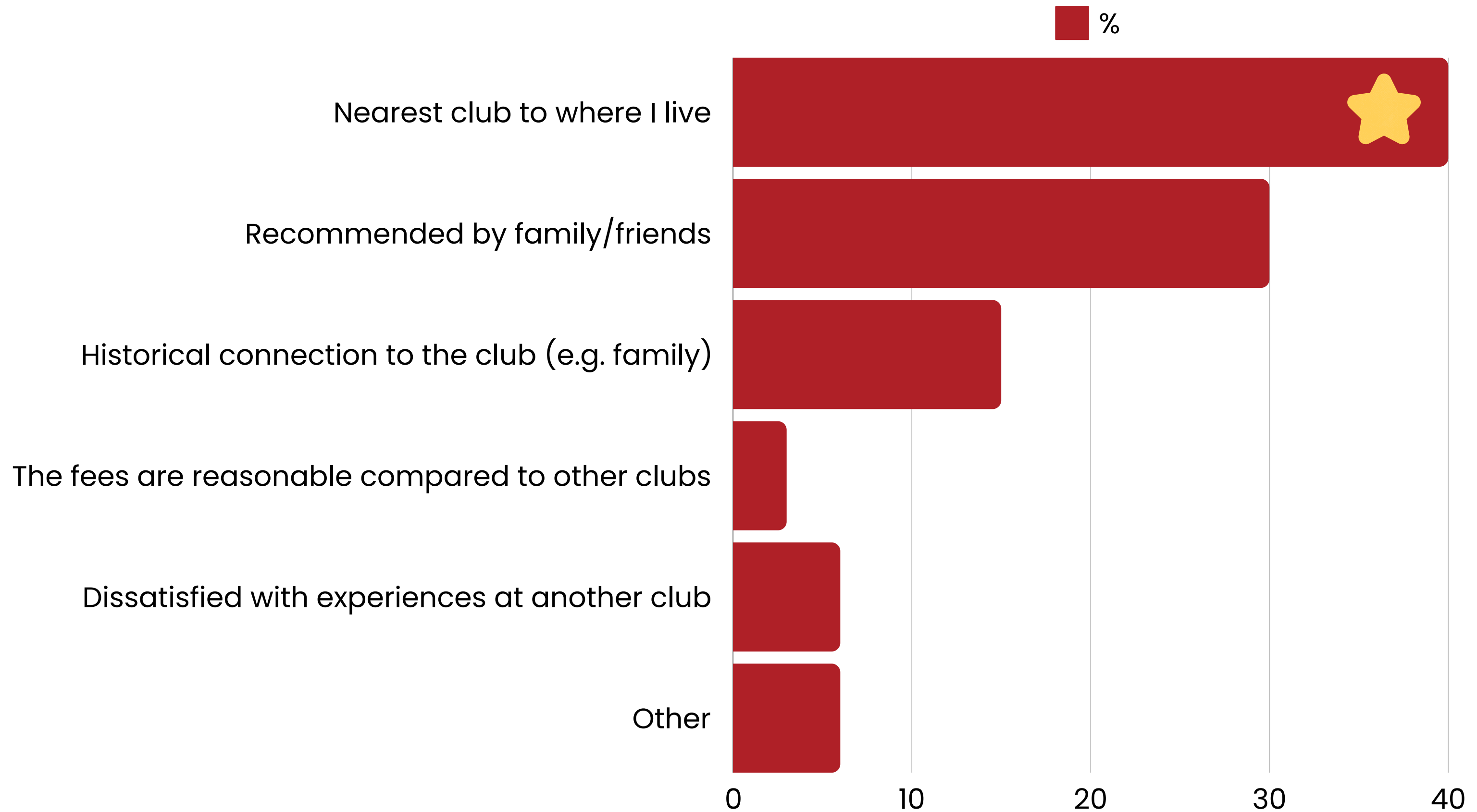
Which role describes you best?



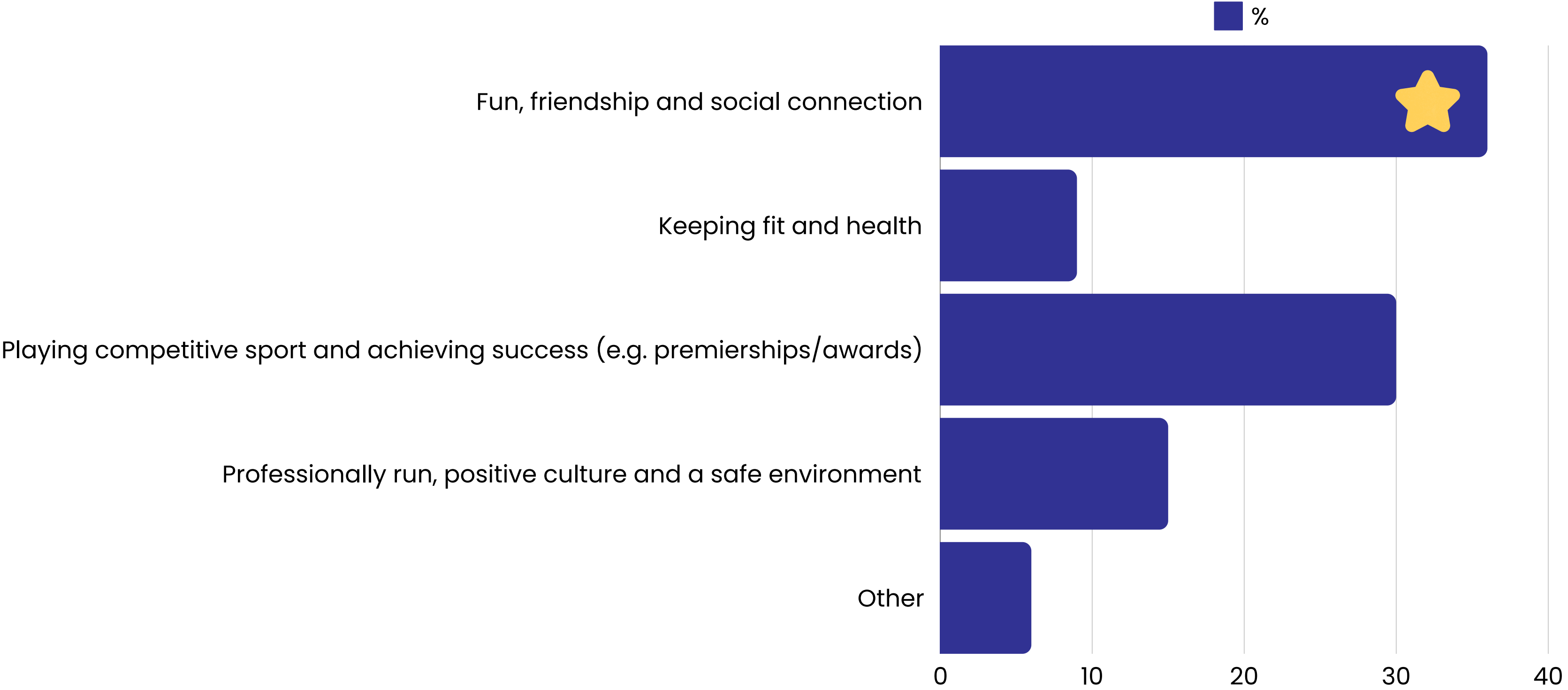

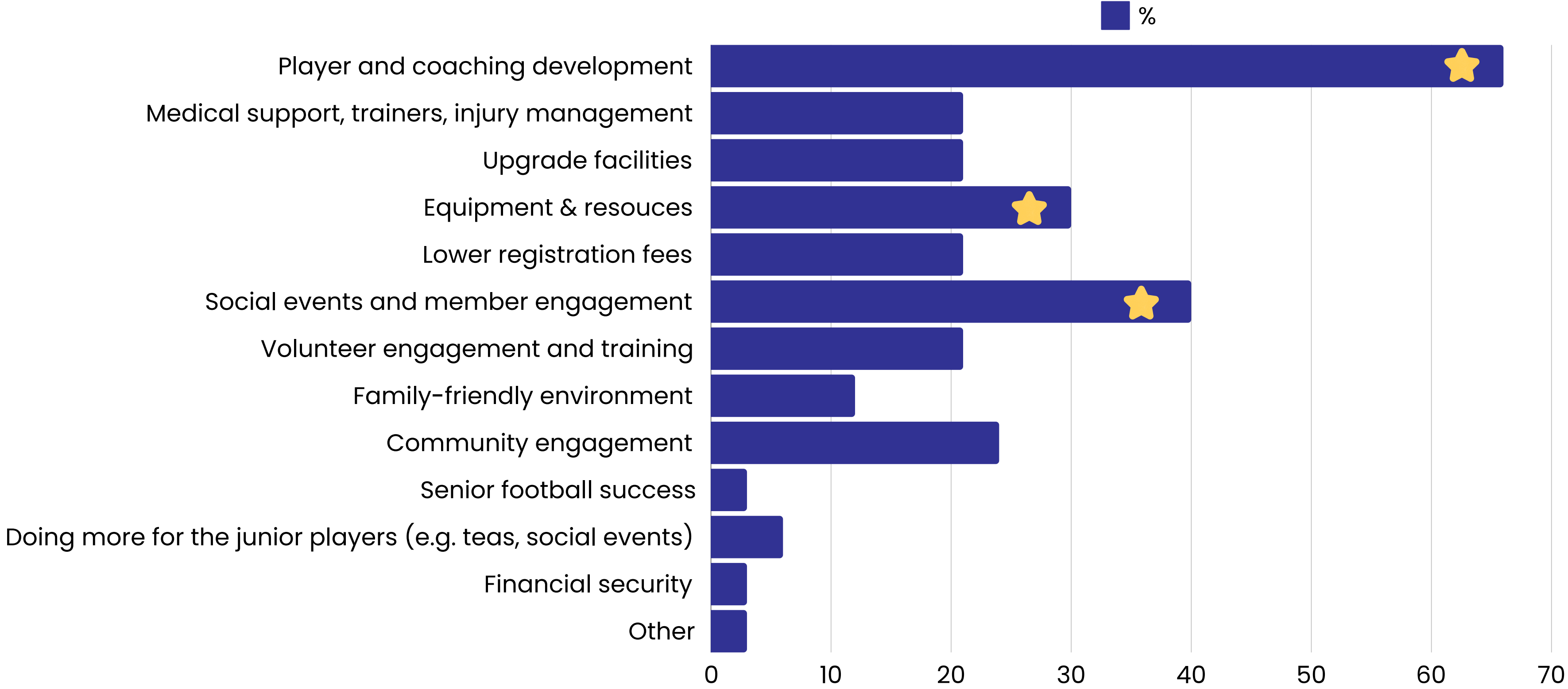
Which of the following best describes the reason why you joined the AFNC?



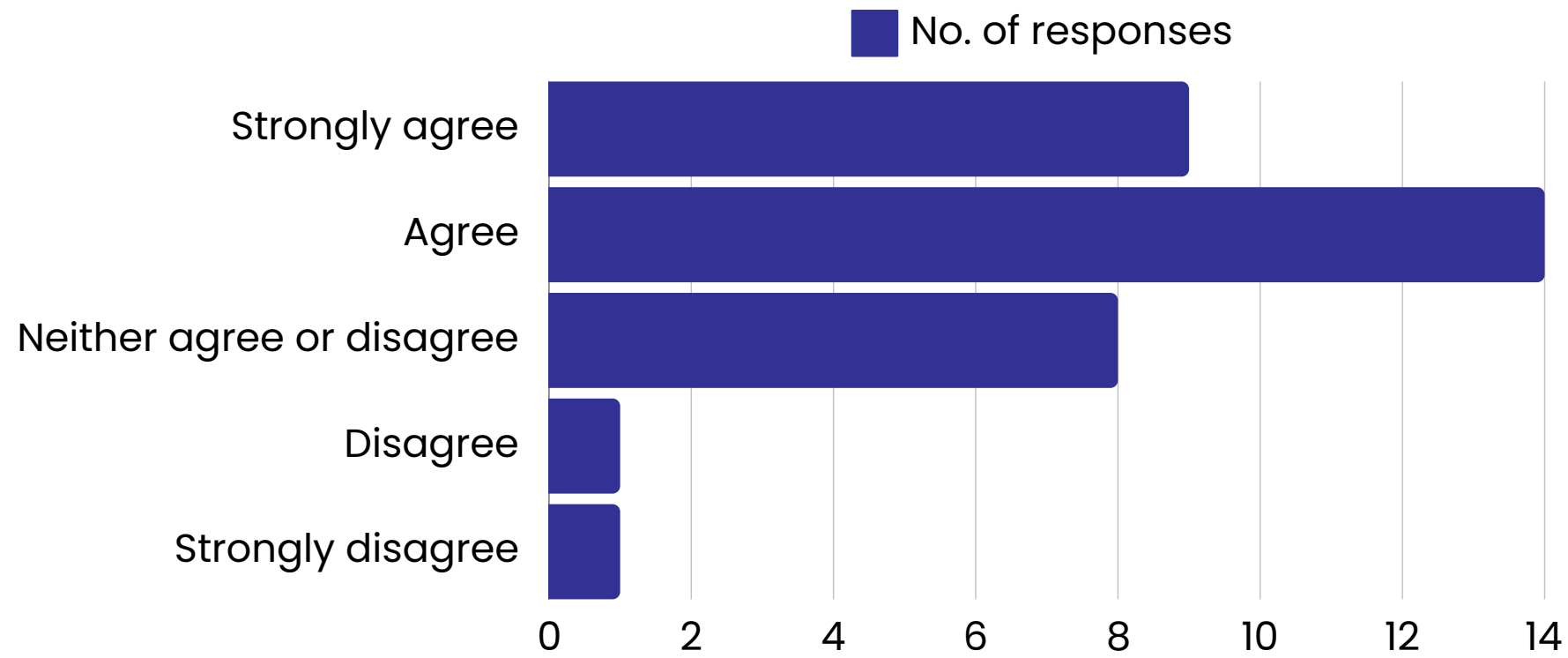

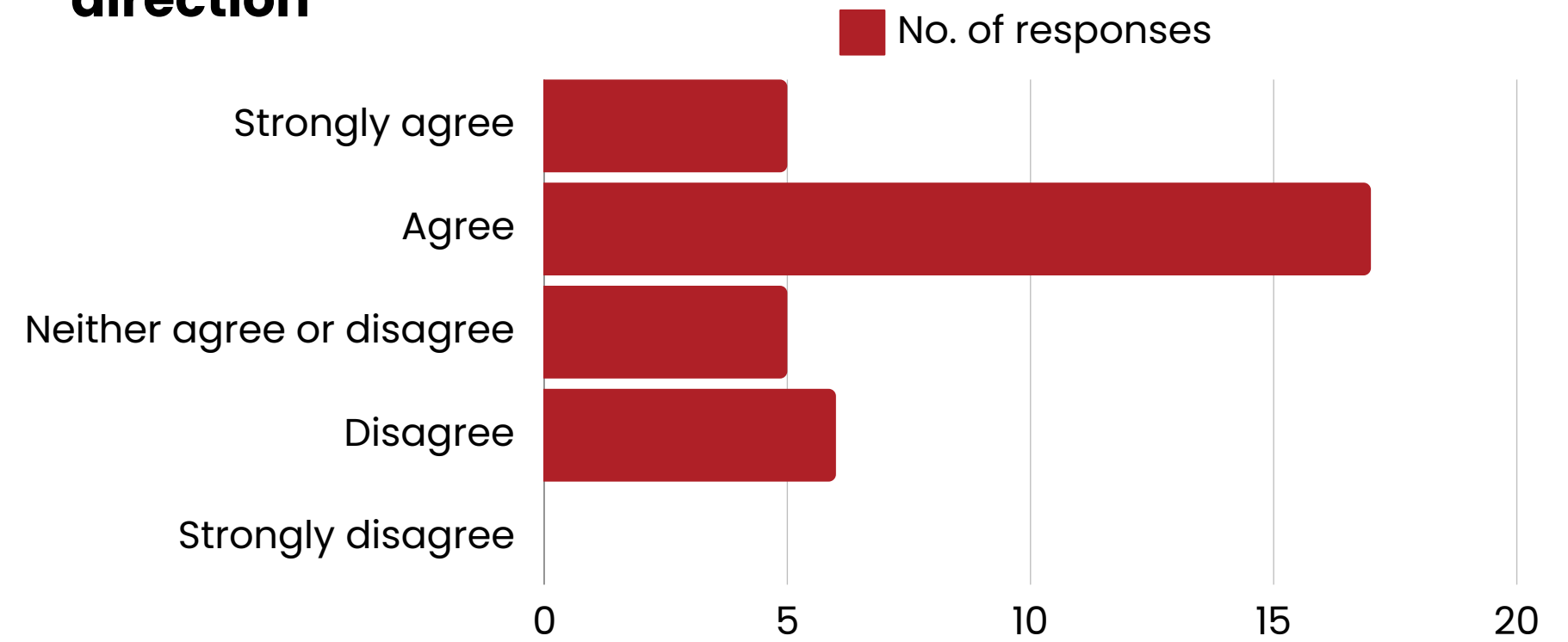

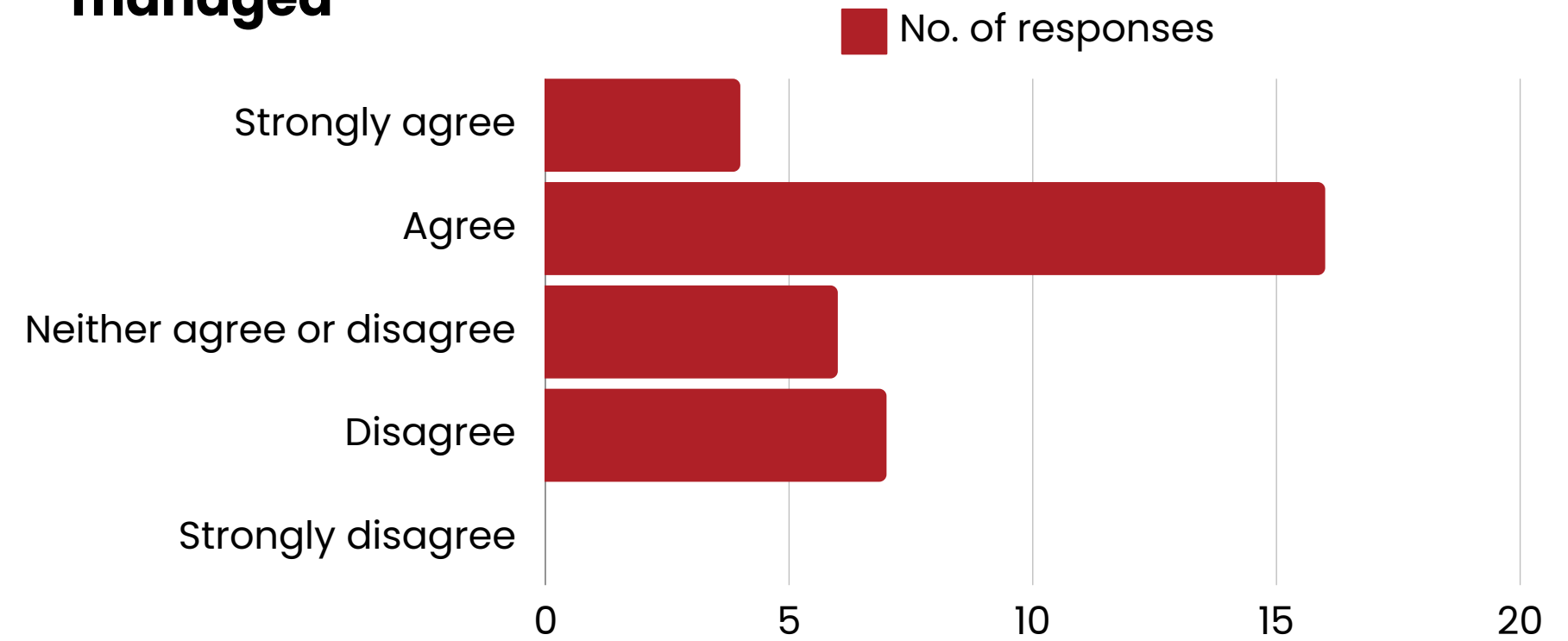

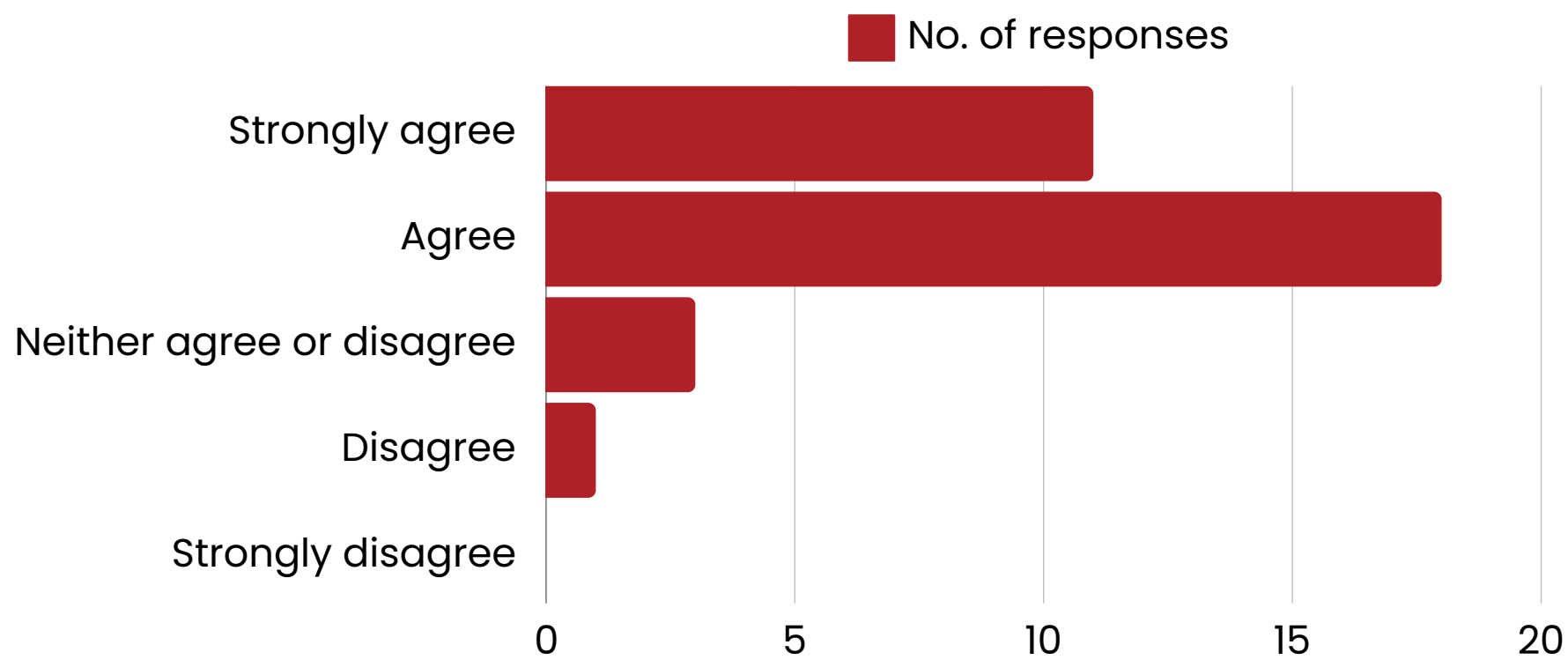

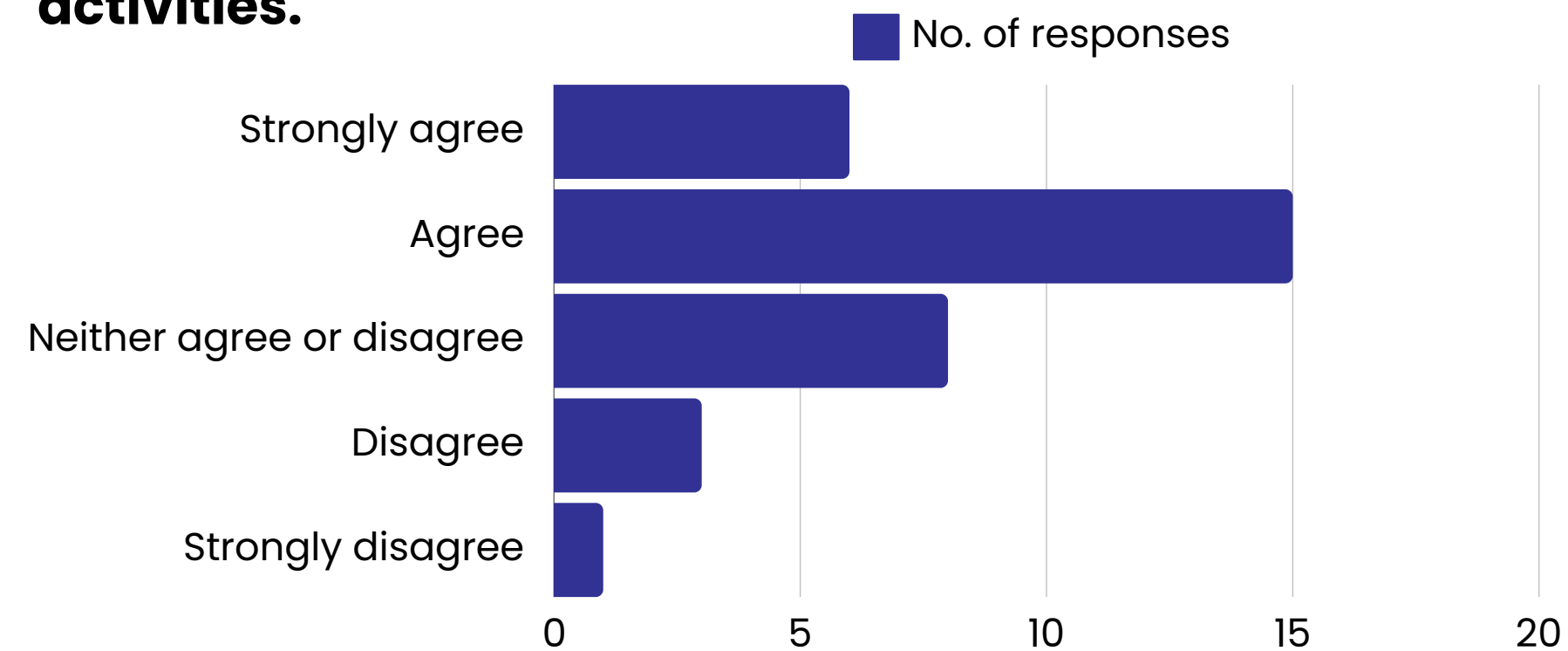

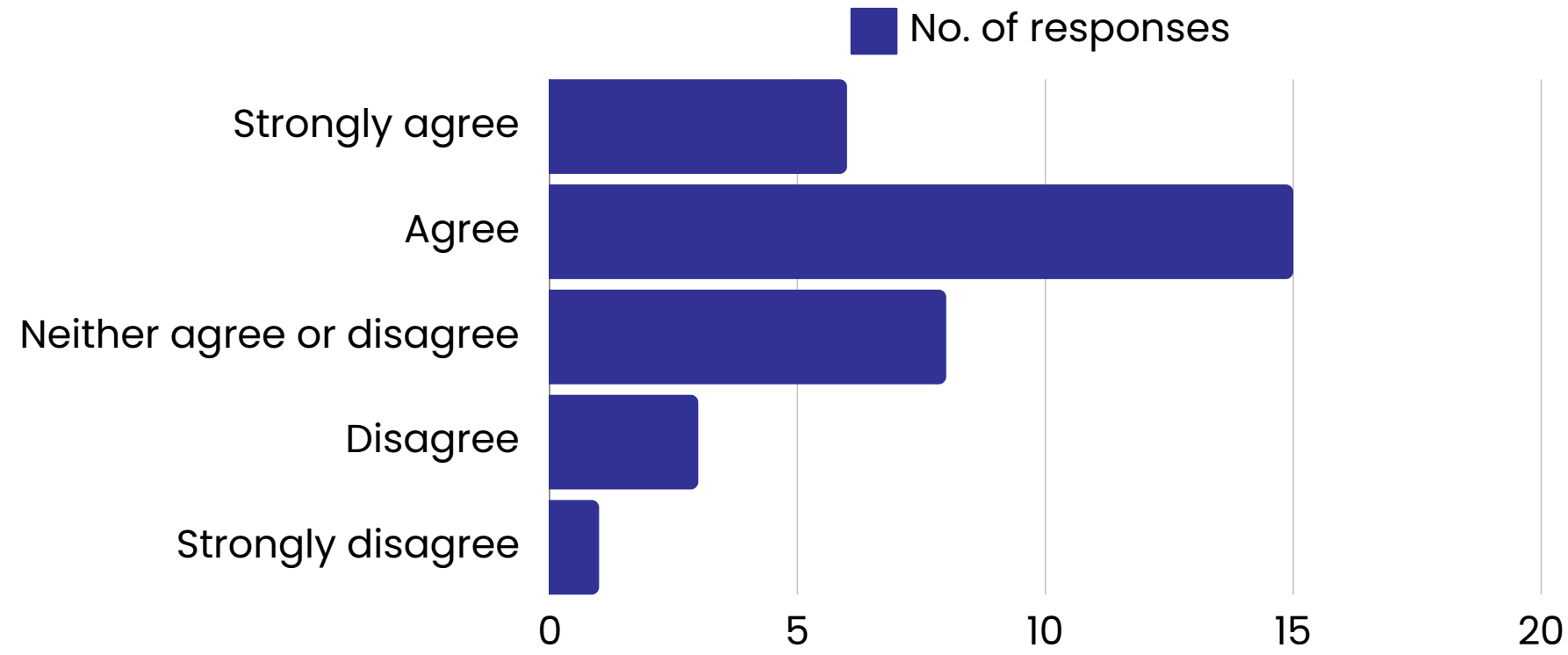

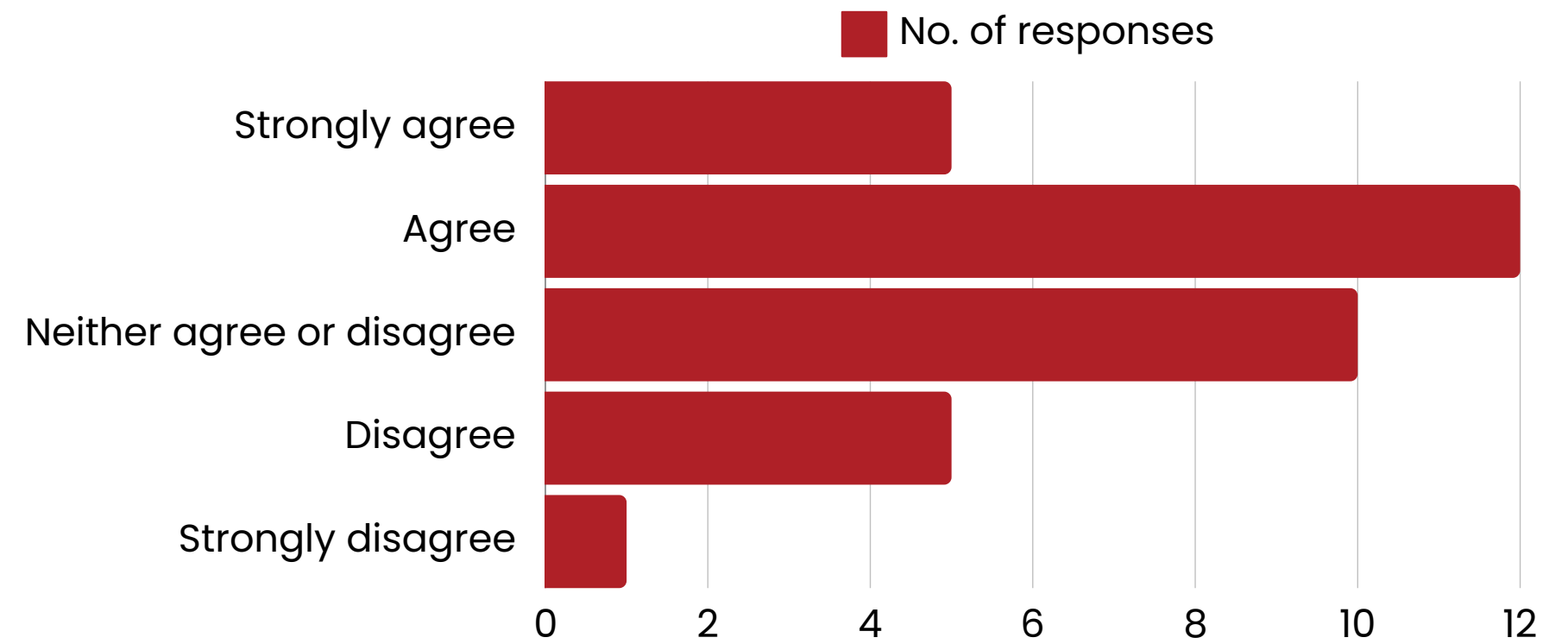

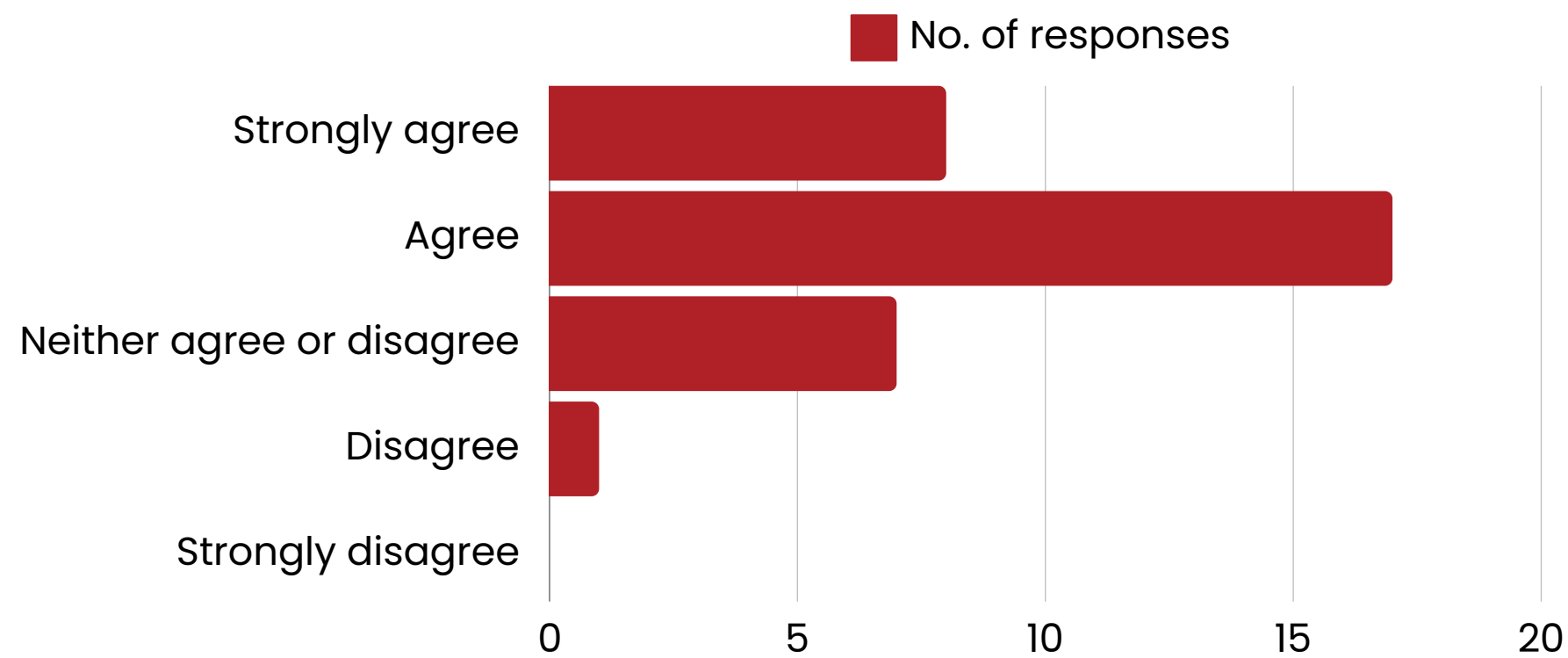

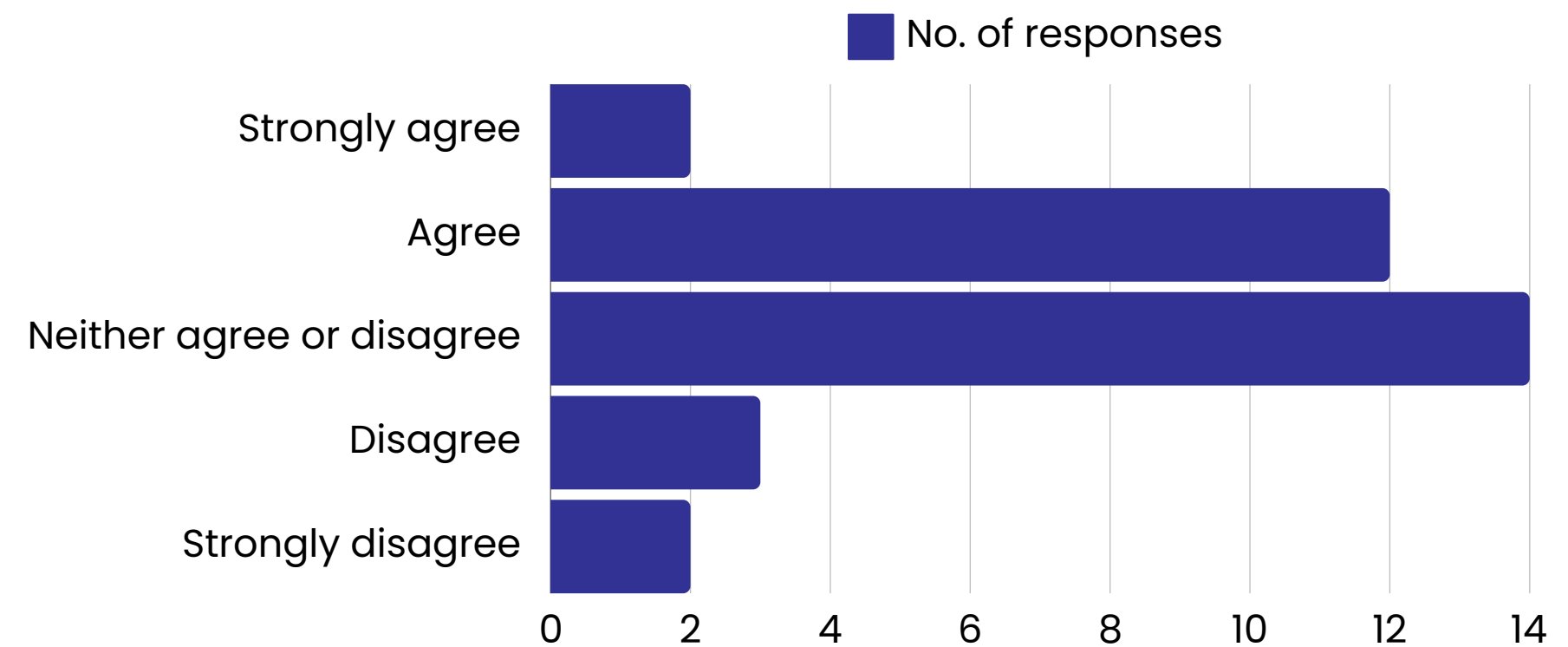

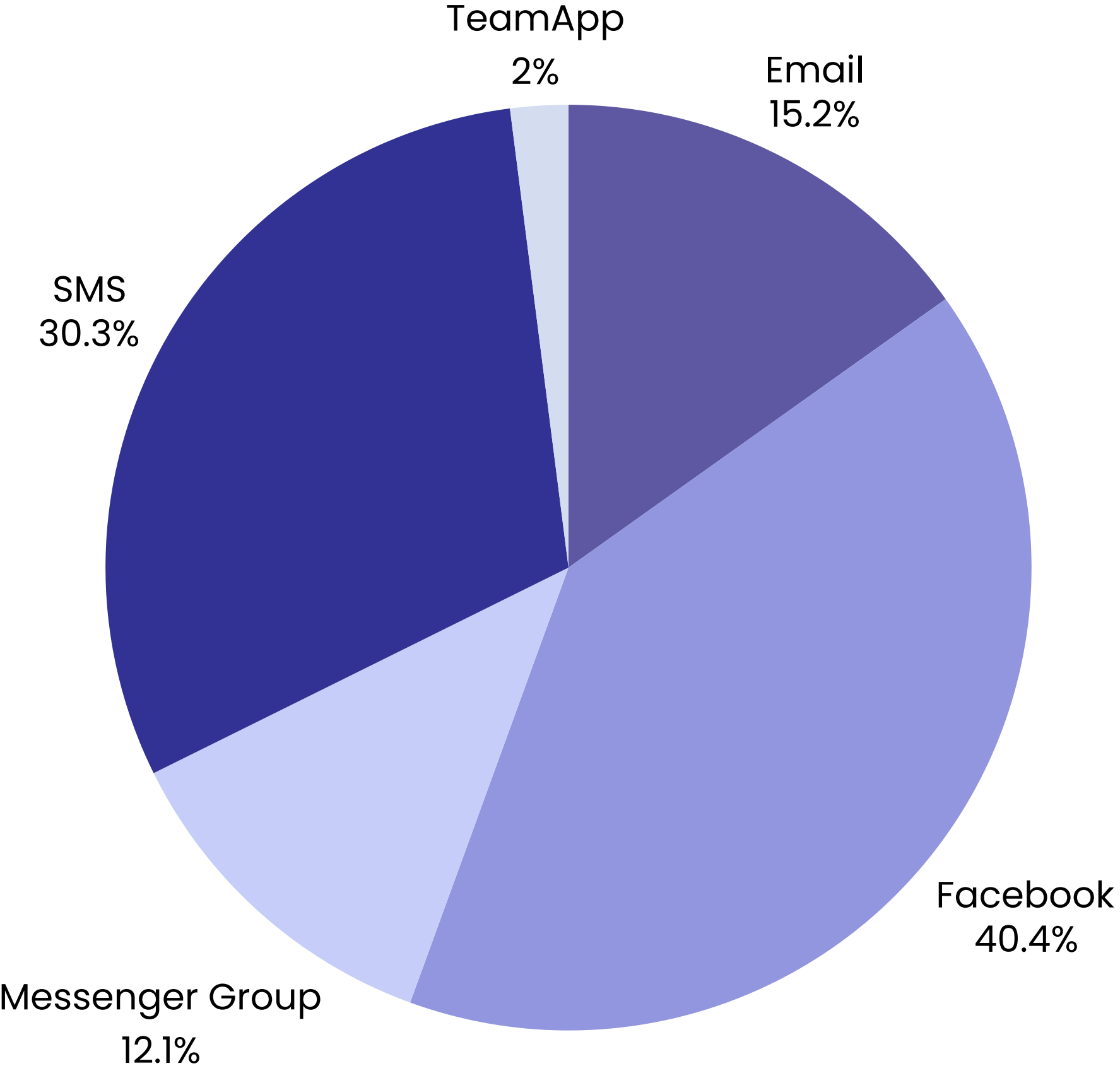

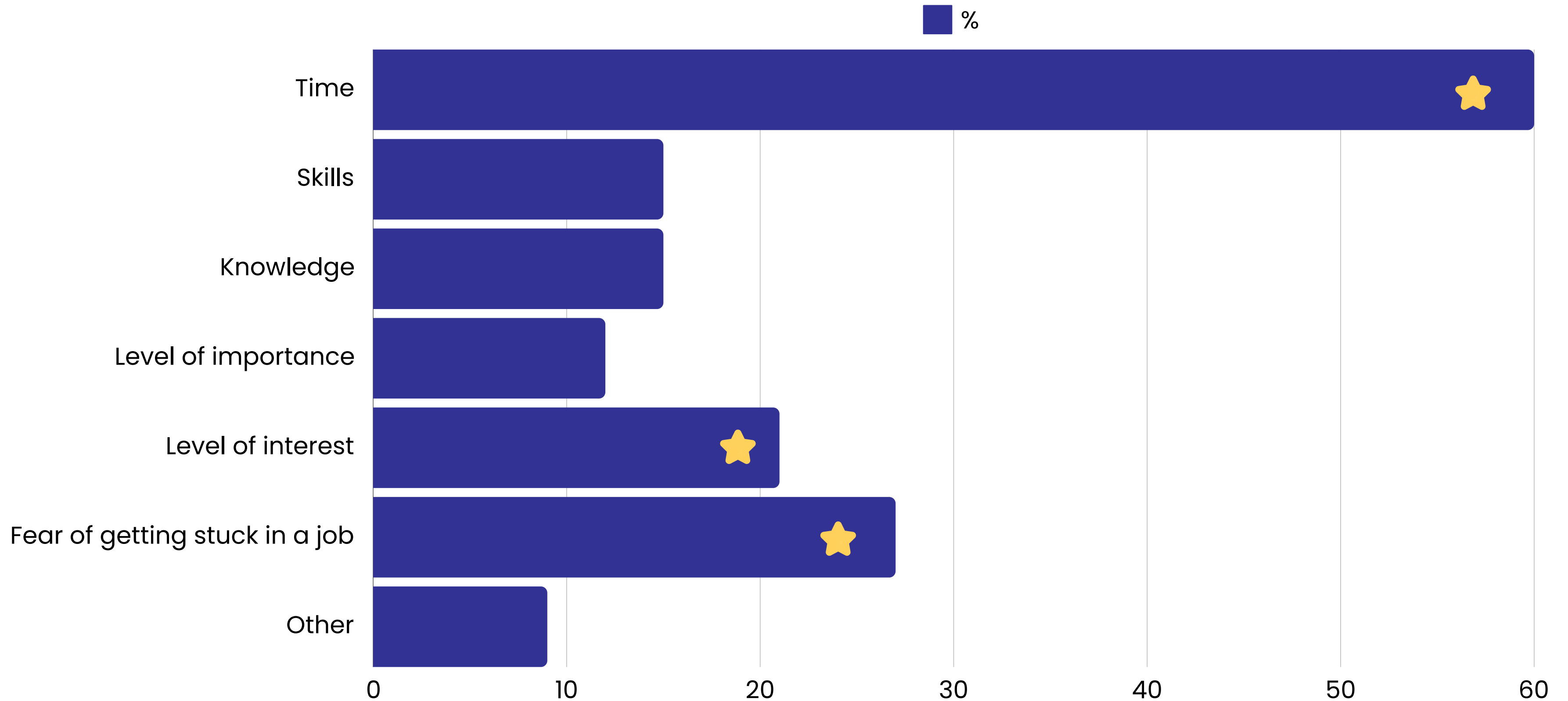


What is the best way to communication with you?

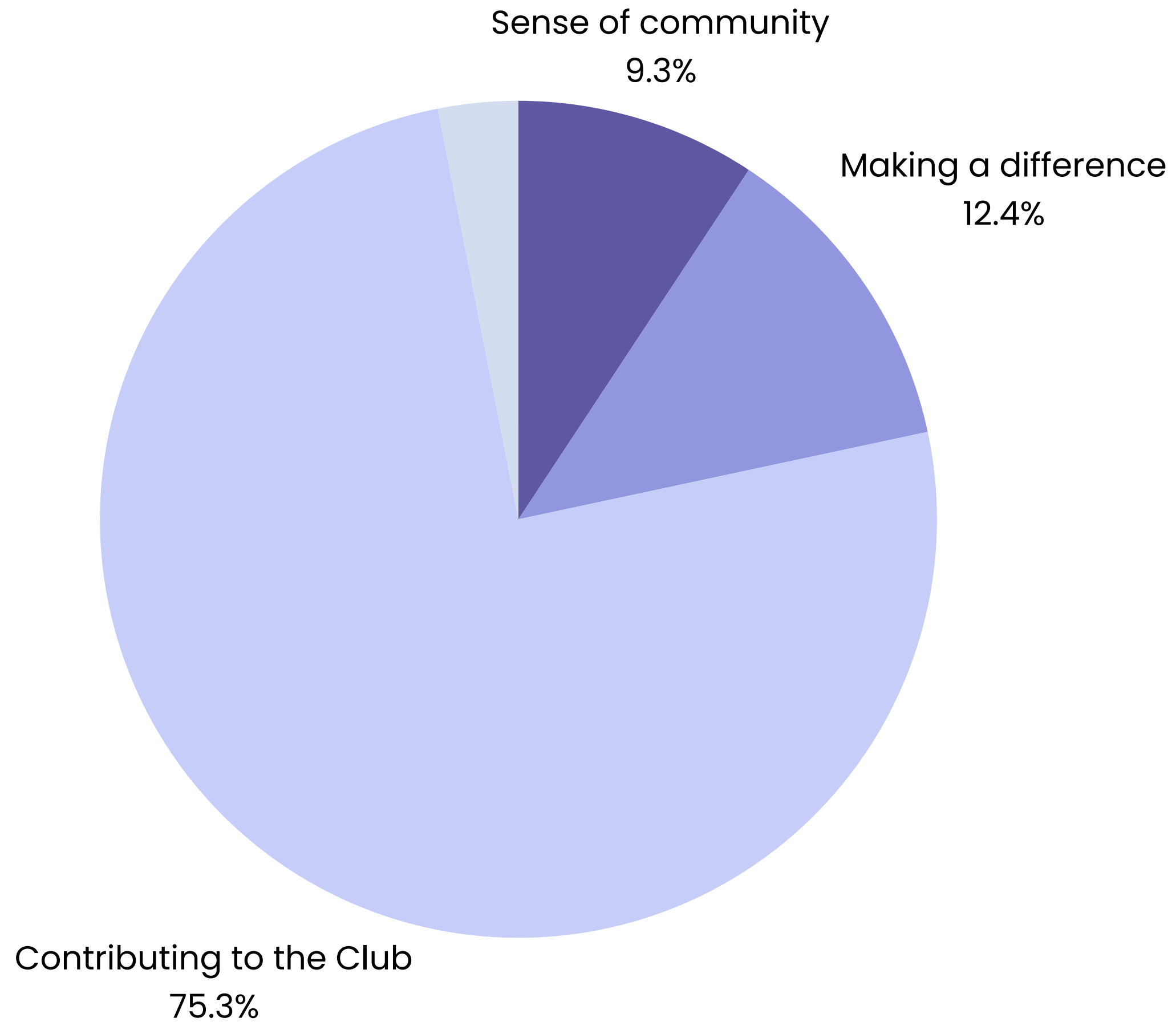
87% of respondants **agree** that the Club communicates effectively with them.



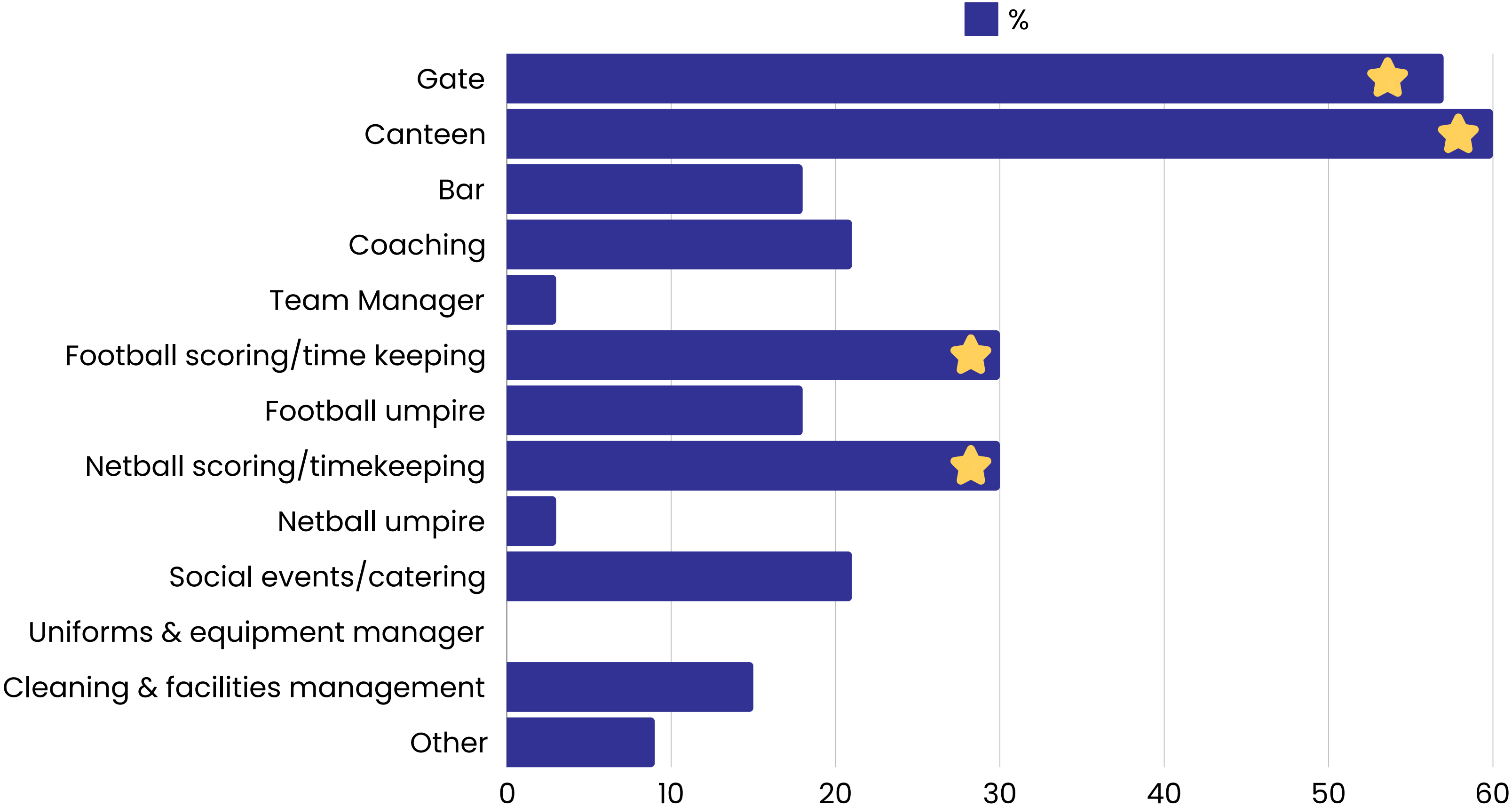
What makes volunteering a challenge?

KEY THEMES – Areas for growth and development

- Social events and functions – increase diversity and inclusion and encourage family-friendly events and activities.
- Enhance competition standards and offer more training and development opportunities for players, coaches, trainers, umpires and volunteers.
- Building strong connections between junior and senior grades, and netball and football teams. Utilise existing activities like Thursday night teas to expand connections.
